A RESOLUTION: IDENTIFYING AN AREA IN THE CITY FOR A SPECIAL NEIGHBORHOOD CLEAN-UP AND "GARAGE SALE" AND SUSPENDING THE REQUIREMENT FOR A CASUAL SALES PERMIT WITHIN THIS DEFINED AREA FOR THE TWO-DAY PERIOD OF JUNE 1st AND 2nd, 2018

WHEREAS, the City wishes to initiate and promote a neighborhood clean-up campaign to encourage the preservation of a well-maintained community; and

WHEREAS, this program should be conducted along with a huge neighborhood “garage sale” to allow residents to sell excess household items before discarding them; and

WHEREAS, in order that the neighborhood be identified and kept to a reasonable size so as to be manageable; and

WHEREAS, A “Casual Sale Permit” is required pursuant to Chapter 812 of the Codified Ordinances, but may be temporarily suspended by Resolution of Council under unique circumstances pursuant to Section 812.04;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ENGLEWOOD, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I That the area boundary as identified on the attached map and made a part hereof is hereby selected as the neighborhood for the proposed garage sale and clean-up and is marked “Exhibit A”.

SECTION II That the requirement for a “Casual Sale Permit” for this identified area is hereby suspended for a forty-eight (48) hour period beginning on Friday, June 1st and ending Saturday, June 2nd, 2018.

SECTION III That City Council encourages the entire community to participate in this activity and hereby proclaims the period between June 1st and June 2nd, 2018 as ‘**CLEAN-UP/FIX-UP WEEK**’.

SECTION IV

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

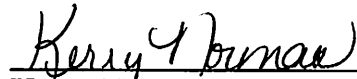
SECTION V

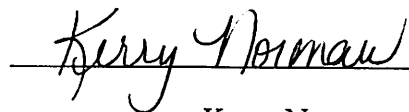

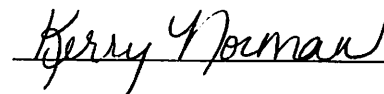
