A RESOLUTION: AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO RENEW AN AGREEMENT WITH SUPERIOR DENTAL CARE, INC. TO PROVIDE A DENTAL INSURANCE PROGRAM FOR THE BENEFIT OF FULL-TIME CITY OF ENGLEWOOD EMPLOYEES.

WHEREAS, The City of Englewood has retained the services of McGohan Brabender, Inc. to act as broker for employee health and welfare benefits; and

WHEREAS, McGohan Brabender has presented the City of Englewood with a comprehensive renewal analysis comparing dental insurance products and rates for several companies; and

WHEREAS, the current Superior Dental Care, Inc. dental insurance agreement is renewable for an additional one year period with a rate increase of 0% in premiums for the benefit year beginning April 1, 2015.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ENGLEWOOD, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to renew an agreement with *Superior Dental Care, Inc., 6683 Centerville Business Parkway, Dayton, OH 45459*, to provide a dental insurance program, based on 65 currently participating employees, such agreement to be effective April 1, 2015 through March 31, 2016.

The estimated maximum benefit year cost, based on current participation levels, shall not exceed FIFTY-FOUR THOUSAND DOLLARS AND ZERO CENTS (\$54,000.00).

SECTION II It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the Passage of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and

of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION III

That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect at the earliest date allowed by law.
