Bulk Pick Up Guidelines

To ensure the safety of Rumpke's drivers, please follow these guidelines when disposing of bulk materials. For more information, please contact the **City of Englewood** at **(937) 836-5106, ext. 212.**

- ✓ **Carpet:** Carpet must be cut down to 4 foot lengths, rolled up and securely tied. Please hammer any nails down for safety.
- ✓ **Wood:** Wood must be bundled in 2 foot by 4 foot bundles and securely tied. Please remove or hammer any nails down for safety.
- ✓ **Fencing:** Fencing must be bundled in 4 foot lengths, rolled and securely tied.
- ✓ **Metal Poles:** Metal poles must be cut down to 4 foot lengths. Cement must be removed.
- ✓ **Furniture:** Furniture is accepted with no special restrictions.
- ✓ **Appliances:** Appliances containing freon (air conditioners, refrigerators, etc.) must have all CFCs removed. Proper identification of CFC removal must be clearly attached to appliances. Please remove doors from refrigerators and freezers for safety reasons.
- ✓ **Construction Debris:** Construction debris must be disposed of in bags or cans weighing no more than 60 pounds. Please do not place debris in boxes or loose.
- ✓ **Railroad Ties & Landscape Timbers:** These must be cut down to 4 foot lengths and stacked neatly.
- ✓ **Patio Doors:** Patio doors must be wrapped in tape or carpet to prevent injury from broken glass.
- ✓ **Other items:** Items containing gasoline, oil or other fluids must be drained before removal. Household items should be in bags or cans.

Please place all items at curbside by 6:00 a.m. on your regularly scheduled waste collection day to ensure proper collection. Carry out stops must also place bulk items at curbside. Thank you for your cooperation.

Not Acceptable Items: Car batteries, household chemicals, car and truck tires, yard waste, rocks, dirt, concrete, liquids and explosives are not acceptable items for disposal.
