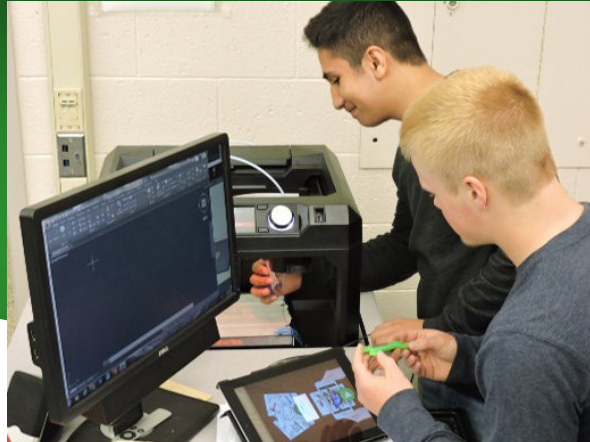

## Our Programs

### **Excellence for Every Child**

Northmont City Schools offers a K-12 education for students from Clayton, Englewood, Phillipsburg, Union and parts of Clay Township, providing a strong foundation for post high school plans of additional education, military or employment.

### **Child Find**

In accordance with the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA), Northmont Schools work hard to identify every child with special needs and provide them with the very best services. Once the school district is notified regarding a child who is suspected of having a disability, the child's parent(s) are contacted and informed of their rights, as required by the IDEA, and arrangements are made with the parents to evaluate the suspected disability.

### **Gifted Intervention**

Students who score in the 95th percentile on standardized tests are eligible for extended services. Elementary students receive specialized instruction from Gifted Intervention Specialists (GIS) one morning or afternoon a week. The GIS provide service by offering materials, ideas for differentiation and assistance to teachers. Middle school students also receive services from specialists. High schoolers are served through Advance Placement (AP) courses, Honors classes and Dual Credit enrollment courses.

## Our Activities

### **Academic Challenge**

Our state-ranked Academic Challenge team has won its conference 18 times and has been undefeated in the conference for six consecutive years.

### **Athletics**

We offer a wide variety of competitive athletics including football, soccer, volleyball, gymnastics, golf, basketball, bowling, wrestling, baseball, softball and swimming.

### **Band/Choir**
