The City of Englewood Water Treatment Plant will be taking its softening system offline for scheduled maintenance. This maintenance is expected to last approximately two months. During this time, you may notice minor changes in your water quality. Household soaps and detergents may not lather as easily, and you might see a white, chalky residue—commonly known as limescale—around faucets, sinks, and showerheads. These are typical signs of mineral buildup from hard water. If you have an in-home water softener, you may notice a slight increase in the hardness of incoming water, as the municipal supply will no longer be pre-softened during this period. Please be assured that this temporary change does not pose any health risks. The water remains safe for all uses. We appreciate your patience and understanding as we complete this important maintenance to ensure the continued quality of your water service.
