A RESOLUTION: AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT A CLEAN

OHIO FUND GRANT APPLICATION FOR GREEN SPACE CONSERVATION AND EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS

ASSOCIATED WITH THE PROJECT

WHEREAS, The Clean Ohio Green Space Conservation Program helps to fund preservation of open spaces, sensitive ecological areas, and stream corridors; and

WHEREAS, the City of Englewood has successfully negotiated a purchase contract for the property at 550 S. Main Street in the amount of \$50,000, contingent on receiving a Clean Ohio Fund Grant; and

WHEREAS, the total project cost is estimated at \$88,000 with 75% funding from Clean Ohio Fund and 25% provided by the City of Englewood; and

WHEREAS, applications must include support for the project from the local jurisdiction and must be reviewed by the legislative authority of each applicant;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ENGLEWOOD, COUNTY OF MONTGOMERY, STATE OF OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I That the city manager be herewith authorized to act, and designated as the

official representative of Englewood, in conjunction with all aspects of the preparation, filing and submittal of documentation necessary for participation in the Clean Ohio Fund grant application to secure funding for the purchase

of real property located at 550 S. Main Street.

SECTION II The city manager is further authorized to sign all documents associated with

the purchase of the property at 550 S. Main Street at the purchase contract

price of \$50,000.

SECTION III That City Council hereby understands and agrees that participation in the

Program will require compliance with program guidelines and assurances.

SECTION IV That City Council hereby commits itself to provide necessary funds as

described in the application, and authorizes the City Manager to expend those

funds.

SECTION V

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this council concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were taken in open meetings of this council, and that all deliberations of this council and/or any committees that resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION VI

That this resolution shall be in full force and effect at the earliest date allowed by law.
