INFORMATION FOR CANDIDATES AND CAMPAIGN MANAGERS ON POLITICAL SIGN REGULATIONS WITHIN THE CITY OF ENGLEWOOD, OHIO

A POLITICAL SIGN PERMIT IS REQUIRED for the erection of political signs. A single permit, for which **NO FEE IS CHARGED**, is to be secured for **EACH CANDIDATE OR ISSUE** and will cover all signs erected during a campaign.

Political signs are regulated by Chapter 1282 of The Englewood Codified Ordinances. General provisions of the ordinance are set out below; specific application of the regulations requires careful reading of the ordinance text. For ease of understanding, this summary indicates when or where political signs are **PROHIBITED**:

1. In any street right-of-way (including the area between the curb and the back of the sidewalk where sidewalks exit.)
2. Before 45 days before Election Day and after five (5) days after Election Day.
3. From being illuminated in a residential district.
4. Closer to the street right-of-way in residential districts than ten (10) feet.
5. Closer to the street right-of-way in commercial districts than ten (10) feet.
6. Larger in area than twelve (12) square feet in residential areas.
7. Larger in area than thirty-two (32) square feet in commercial districts.
8. On utility, street name, traffic signs, or other poles or structures.
9. On either public property or on any property without consent of the owner or tenant.
