A RESOLUTION: AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH COATE CONSTRUCTION FOR CURB AND SIDEWALK REPAIRS

WHEREAS, Englewood has pursued a citywide sidewalk, curbing and driveway apron maintenance program, has duly passed authorizing legislation for such program year after year, and has supplied affected property owners with notification of responsibilities and options pursuant to inspections of their property; and

WHEREAS, bids from contractors for work identified by the year 2003 sidewalk, curbing and driveway apron maintenance program were solicited by advertisement in a newspaper of general circulation and by other means, and were opened and read aloud on June 30, 2003; and

WHEREAS, the contract authorized by Council resolution 26-03 was lowest of the six responsive bids received for the year 2003 sidewalk, curbing and driveway apron maintenance program; and

WHEREAS, the contractor awarded a contract for year 2003 sidewalk program repairs agreed to hold the same price for years 2004 through 2018 and now again for year 2019, in accordance with provisions of Section 232.10(m), Purchasing Contract Renewals, of the Englewood Codified Ordinances;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ENGLEWOOD, COUNTY OF MONTGOMERY, STATE OF OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I That the City Manager be hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Coate Construction Company, at a cost for work specified not to exceed Two-HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$250,000), to construct sidewalk, curbing and driveway apron repairs pursuant to the approved maintenance program for same established by Englewood.


SECTION II That any additional work related to like items of construction be limited to the unit prices supporting the lowest qualified bid submitted by Coate Construction Company, Inc.

SECTION III It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this council concerning and relating to passage of this resolution were taken in open meetings of this council, and that all deliberations of this council, and of any committees, that resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION VI That this resolution shall be in full force and effect at the earliest date allowed by law.




