ORDINANCE: 20 – 17

PASSED: DECEMBER 8, 2020

AN ORDINANCE: APPROVING REZONE #20-10, REMOVING 6 ACRES ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF W. NATIONAL ROAD, DIRECTLY SOUTH OF CHRIS DRIVE, FROM R-1 RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT AND PLACING THE SAME IN AN S-PUD ZONING DISTRICT, APPROVING THE CONCEPT PLAN AND NEW LOT

WHEREAS, a concept plan has been submitted by Dayton Metro Library for redevelopment of a site zoned “R-1” at 700 W. National Road; and

WHEREAS, a new lot will be created containing six (6) acres and creating a new record plan; and

WHEREAS, said property currently lies within a “R-1” Residential Zoning District, and a proper application has been filed for rezoning to a “S-PUD” Special Planned Unit Development District; and

WHEREAS, a site development plan has been submitted in support of “S-PUD” zoning; has been judged conditionally adequate by reference to Section 1264.03(e), “Required Contents ...”, of the Zoning Code; and this Board has made required findings of fact called for by Section 1264.03(h) of said Zoning Code; and

WHEREAS, notifications of public hearings on matters outlined herein were advertised in a newspaper of general circulation and were mailed to all property owners within 200 feet of the subject property; and

WHEREAS, this proposal has received a recommendation for conditional approval from the Planning Commission;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ENGLEWOOD, COUNTY OF MONTGOMERY, STATE OF OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I That the “S-PUD” application, site development plan submitted by Mike Ruetschle, Architect for Dayton Metro Library, pertaining to 700 W. National Road, be herewith conditionally approved.

SECTION II That any redevelopment of the subject site, pursuant to such approvals, occur only if:

- a) Final landscaping and screening plans shall be approved by staff before the issuance of building permits. Parking shall meet the standards for individual land uses, as is presently codified by Section 1266.05 (c) of the Zoning Code.
- b) Site development plans are reviewed and approved by the City’s consulting civil and traffic engineers.
- c) All building elevations are constructed of brick, or similar masonry material, as proposed by the applicant and are judged by staff

to be complementary to adjacent land uses and in compliance with city requirements.

d) All review and permit fees normally collected, all sureties normally posted, and all other actions and/or arrangements called for by applicable sections of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Englewood, be accomplished by the developer(s).

SECTION III

The applicant is further approved to make minor site design modifications to provide for improved traffic movements if determined necessary by the City's consulting traffic or civil engineer.

SECTION IV

All signs must conform to the setback and size limits as required by the Englewood Codified Ordinances.

SECTION V






