Runs from the back of Centennial Park out to West National Road and west to the Englewood YMCA

## Union Boulevard Bikeway

Runs the length of Union Boulevard between West National Road and I-70



## Pauly Drive Bikeway



Connects and runs behind Pauly Drive near Carr Woods Reserve and joins with the Englewood YMCA bikeway in Centennial Park

Three miles of meandering bike trails will take you through wonderful natural scenery and along the tranquil shores of the Scenic Stillwater River.




The trail begins behind Miami Valley North Health Center at Jake Grossnickle Memorial Park where parking is available.

The Englewood Reserve Bikeway joins with the Englewood MetroPark bike paths on the north side of the Englewood Dam.

Englewood MetroPark's (East Park) trails are color coded and looped. You will simply need to follow the colored circles on the posts, and you will return to your starting point.

- green = 3.8 mile
- purple = .5 mile
- blue = .5 mile (wheelchair accessible trail)
- white = 1.2 mile
- yellow = .8 mile
- orange = .7 mile
- black = .4 mile
