ORDINANCE: 25-14

PASSED: DECEMBER 9, 2025

AN ORDINANCE: APPROVING THE EDITING AND INCLUSION OF CERTAIN ORDINANCES AS PARTS OF THE VARIOUS COMPONENT CODES OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR THE ADOPTION AND PUBLICATION OF NEW MATTER IN THE UPDATED AND REVISED CODIFIED ORDINANCES; AND REPEALING ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS IN CONFLICT THEREWITH

WHEREAS, American Legal Publishing has completed its annual updating and revision of the Codified Ordinances of the City; and

WHEREAS, general and permanent legislation enacted by Council from the date of the last updating and revision of the Codified Ordinances through October 22, 2024, has now been integrated into the Codified Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, certain changes were made in the Codified Ordinances to bring City law into conformity with State law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ENGLEWOOD, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: The editing, arrangement and numbering or renumbering of the following ordinances and parts of ordinances are hereby approved as parts of the various component codes of the Codified Ordinances of the City, so as to conform to the classification and numbering system of the Codified Ordinances:

SECTION II: The following sections are or contain new matter in the Codified Ordinances and are hereby approved, adopted and enacted:

402.226, 402.55, 434.07, 434.08, 436.14, 606.165, 624.01, 666.02, 666.03, 698.05

SECTION III. The following sections are hereby repealed:

624.02 Trafficking in controlled substances; gift of marihuana.
636.22 Failure to perform viability testing.


SECTION IV. All ordinances and resolutions and parts thereof that are in conflict with any of the provisions of the new matter approved, adopted and enacted by Section 2 hereof are hereby repealed, except as follows:

- (a) The enactment of such new matter shall not be construed to affect a right or liability accrued or incurred under any legislative provision prior to the effective date of such right or liability. Such enactment shall not be construed to relieve any person from punishment for an act committed in violation of any such legislative provision or to affect an indictment or prosecution, therefore. For such purposes, any such legislative provision shall continue in full force notwithstanding its repeal for the purposes of revision and recodification.
- (b) The repeal provided above shall not affect any legislation enacted subsequent to October 22, 2024.

SECTION V: Pursuant to R.C. ' 731.23, Section 2.07 of the City Charter and Sections 224.01 and 224.02 of the Codified Ordinances, the Clerk of Council shall cause a copy of this Adopting Ordinance to be posted in the five public places provided in Section 224.01 for not less than 15 days, together with a summary of the new matter approved, adopted and enacted by Section 2 hereof, which summary is attached hereto as Exhibit A.

SECTION VI: This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
